## LAKESIDE STATEWIDE JURIED ART EXHIBITION 2020

### Eligibility

Entry into the **23rd Annual Lakeside Statewide Juried Art Exhibition** is open to all artists 18 years of age and older, living or working in New York State over the last 2 years. Acceptable media include: drawing, painting, sculpture, mixed media, printmaking, photography, digital media, ceramics, and all fine craft. Work previously exhibited at the Oswego Civic Arts Center is not eligible. Work completed prior to 2018 is not eligible. Entries should be appropriate for all ages. All accepted works must arrive suitably framed and ready to hang or otherwise appropriately prepared for immediate installation. Unframed works or works improperly prepared may be rejected. Works may not exceed 72" in any direction. Sculpture may not exceed 100 lbs.

### Awards

\$1,000 in prize money will be awarded including \$300 for Best of Show. Award ceremony will be held at 8:00 PM on opening night.

### Gallery

The Art Association of Oswego (AAO) galleries are housed in the Oswego Civic Arts Center, which is located at the northern end of East Fourth Street in the City of Oswego, directly across from historic Fort Ontario. Regular gallery hours are on Saturdays from 10 AM to 1 PM and on Sundays from 1 PM to 4 PM. The galleries are also open during art classes, theater performances, and by appointment. Entry into the exhibition will constitute agreement by the artist to the terms described herein.

## **2. SUBMIT DIGITAL IMAGES OF YOUR ARTWORK AS ATTACHMENTS TO YOUR EMAIL:**

One image of each artwork entered must be submitted as an individual jpeg file.\*

\*For 3-dimensional works, you may submit up to three views of each work.

Files must be 300 dip resolution, 1 megabyte (100kb) or less in size.

Please consult the AAO website (www.oswegoArts.org) for instructions on resizing large file.

Each digital file must be named with artist's last name plus a shortened version of the artwork's title.  
(eg: a file for Joshua Jones' entry entitled *Black Lake* would be names **JonesBlack.jpg**)
